The Dept. of Children and Families proposed a new quality rating system for childcares in WI. The YoungStar Childcare Rating system proposal has passed. What is it? YoungStar sets a five-star

rating system for child care providers based on education, learning environment, business practices and the health and well being of children. Through this rating system the state will address several key issues in Wisconsin's child care system. It will:

- Improve the overall quality of child care
- Create a clear, understandable tool for parents to choose quality child care
- Create incentives for providers to improve services, particularly for low-income children
- Establish a connection between child care quality and the rate of Wisconsin Shares payments
